

JOB TITLE: Egg Packing Supervisor

SUMMARY OF ROLE: Grading & Packing Eggs:
Once the day's eggs are collected, they are transported to our packing shed. We have a grading machine which weighs, date stamps and packs the eggs. The grading machine handles the eggs automatically, however it does require between 3 to 5 operators to perform various tasks (loading the eggs onto the machine, quality control, packaging supply, and unloading the packed eggs). This work is similar to other production line work environments, each person on the team has a role to play to ensure packing process is carried out efficiently.

This role requires an individual with good mechanical understanding, experience of production line work, and experience of leading a small team.

You will be responsible for ongoing cleaning and maintenance of all equipment.

SKILLS REQUIRED: This is a practical role; common sense & manual dexterity are important. You will be required to do some repetitive manual lifting. A box of eggs can weigh up to 20Kg!

You will need to be a clean and tidy person, food hygiene awareness is of paramount importance.

You will be the leader of a small team of egg packers, it will be your responsibility to ensure that all associated processes run smoothly, you will be responsible for configuring machinery, planning the day's work, and achieving efficient operation.

QUALIFICATIONS REQUIRED:

No formal qualifications are required.
